Three Members of the Laborer’s Union, who were here last Thursday, were present for today’s meeting. Reviewed with Commissioner Striker they are only asking the solar contractors to use Ohio people. Workers don’t have to be union but should be Ohio residents. Stephanie McCullough and Becky Stevenson, **Board of Elections**. They have been speaking to civic groups about the changes in voting due to HB458. July 11 they need the drop box back in place for the camera as that is the first day of voting. That side of the concrete job should be poured first. A bigger job than thought. Becky is retiring July 21. Two positions are being advertised. Next week is the Summer Conference. Ballot language was changed late Tuesday, so Wednesday, they spent changing, which delayed L&A to this morning. August 8 is the State Issue I election. They are combining several precincts and cutting down on poll workers for the day. They would like to take a voting machine to the fair but the Fair Board will not allow them to have a booth for one day. National Poll Worker Day is August 16. Stephanie has plans to extend an invite to all poll workers to meet in Veterans Hall with sandwiches, scavenger hunt in the courthouse with election items (name wallet), photo opportunity, find plaques, etc. Is this okay with the Commissioners to have people walking throughout the courthouse? They will ask each elected official for permission. Plan to share recipes they bring to poll workers day and election day experiences. Independent candidates have until August 9, 2023 to file. 2024 Election petitions are due December 20, 2023. Reimbursements are still being submitted to the Secretary of State for all changes in the election.
